The English department is pleased you are interested in taking on the challenge of Advanced English. Read the following then sign below to indicate agreement to the stipulations therein:

We fully understand the dynamics of the Advanced English courses offered at John Swett High School; the student has every intention of fulfilling (to the best of her/his ability) the requirements of the course, up to, and including, the following:

- Conscientiously maintaining **daily, on time** attendance.
- Completing readings assigned outside of class, homework, and research projects, if applicable. NOTE: students who are earning a D at the end of the first semester will automatically be transferred to college prep English for the second semester, *without exception*.
- Keeping parents informed and actively participating in the educational process occurring in the Advanced English Courses.
- Putting forth your best effort to improve your intellectual growth and development.
- Submitting all work in a timely fashion.
- Adhering to the school's honesty policy (annually reviewed in the Fall.)
- Adhering to the school's behavioral expectations. NOTE: due to the above-mentioned attendance expectation, students who are suspended may be disqualified to be members of the advanced classes.
- Obtaining parent signature along with yours on this contract.
- **Graciously** complying with the *justifiable and reasonable* request by instructor for removal from the class because of failure to comply with pre-established rules and regulations.

Juniors and Seniors only (AP English Language & Composition and AP English Literature & Composition):

- Completing the Summer Project NOTE: students who do not have the project by the end of the first full week of class (August 25, 2023) **may** be automatically transferred to college prep English to allow room for any "wait listed" students who **are** prepared with the project.
- Taking the AP English Language or Literature & Composition exam given in the first two weeks of May 2024.

NOTE: students who sign up for, then drop, advanced level courses will be given a lower priority for subsequent advanced English course requests.

This contract is due ***no later than*** Friday, June 2, 2023 (or August 25th, 2023 for **new** or "wait listed" Advanced English candidates.)
