EXAMPLE: "And the gods hated him from above" (15).</b>	<b>THREE PER READING. Costa Level II Questions: Analysis/Inference (The act or process of deriving logical conclusions from premises known or assumed to be true) Implicit or what is implied; analysis, ask how and why, require analysis of the text, reading between the lines, hidden meaning. (understood, though not directly expressed) Key words: analyze, categorize, explain classify, compare, contrast, infer, organize, sequence.</b>
